I pray all of you are enjoying a terrific summer – and greetings to all of you, beloved in the Lord. In this fifth Presiding Bishop's Epistle, I relish the chance to share with all of you once again the inspiring news which persistently defines our Church family and to provide updates on future happenings. It remains the venture of a lifetime to travel throughout the Eastern United States and North America, to visit and encourage as many of our churches and faithful as possible, and to eyewitness the perennial advancement and deepening of our Church's communion. In my daily prayers, I praise God for all of you.

The 2023 Lenten Appeal – now, the Summer Appeal

As you know, this year we have taken a more 'outside the box,' or imaginative, approach to the annual APA Lenten Appeal, as we seek to rejuvenate one of our most promising missions with the sponsorship of a brilliant man who is preparing to be sent immediately upon ordination to the Diaconate. Saint Thomas the Apostle Church in Alto, Georgia will receive the support of our jurisdiction through the funding of Mr. Ian Jarrells, who will serve as Saint Thomas' new Vicar.

The exciting news is that we have been able to raise approximately \$60,000 toward the goal of \$100,000 for a three-year funding programme. The challenging news is that we still need to raise \$40,000 to reach our target. So now, the time between the summer months and Synod is the optimal period in which for us to achieve this great work for Our Lord. We urge our faithful and clergy to be generous as we seek to 'cross the finish line' and create a real and lasting impact for our Church in north Georgia. If one's parish or mission has not yet advertised the Appeal, it is not too late at all – now is the perfect time. If one has not yet contributed to this effort financially, the prime window is open at this very moment. We do need your help, and we are intensely thankful for your support.

Your prayers are profusely appreciated as Ian looks to serve Christ's flock in Alto, Georgia. We are filled with hope for Ian, his wife Joy, and the faithful community of Saint Thomas, as the Lord Jesus continues to build His Church. Please continue to be generous— and may the Lord richly bless your generosity and magnanimity.

News Notes

We are edified to be able to announce that a new mission is in the formation process in the Ocala, Florida area, in which the Anglican faithful loyal to the Continuing Church will now have a Church home again. Very soon, Saint Augustine of Canterbury Mission will be given sanction and recognition, and the Reverend Mr. Allen Ryan will be assigned as Deacon-in-Charge. Please pray for the work and ministry of Deacon Al and for our Church family there.

We are also happy to announce that the Reverend Father Peter Joslyn has accepted the call to serve as the new curate of Saint Alban's Cathedral, Oviedo, Florida, to serve under its Dean, the Very Reverend Ralph Waterhouse. We wish Father Peter, Erin, and their family every blessing in their move and new endeavours. The quintessentially important role of assistant priest at Lindisfarne Hall and Holy Trinity Church, Fernandina Beach, under the Reverend Father Bradley Cunningham, is now available and ready – and we eagerly encourage any priests who may be interested in that vibrant and vital ministry please to contact us.

The Reverend Father Mark Perkins has accepted the call to serve as the Chaplain of Saint Dunstan's Academy, our residential school for young men, which has now acquired a breathtakingly idyllic and expansive farm property in Nelson County, Virginia. Father Mark will work full-time alongside Mr. Thomas Fickley and his family, beginning in August, to promote, build, and extend the ministry of Saint Dunstan's Academy, and in so doing, Father Mark becomes the first professional school and mission Chaplain for an Anglican residential academy in the history of the Continuum. One

step at a time, the true Anglican Communion is being restored and reinvigorated. No more substantial evidence for the burgeoning health and growth of the Continuing Church could be envisioned. Please pray for Father Mark, Andrea, and their family, the Fickleys, and all involved as they launch out in faith to take on this new assignment.

May into July

In May, I was able to meet via Zoom with the Vestry of Saint Luke's Church, Port Orange, Florida, which continues to benefit from the services of the Reverend Father Jeffrey Steel. On the weekend of 14th May, I was delighted once more to visit Saint George the Martyr Church, Simpsonville, South Carolina, which evinces more and more growth and size every time one visits. The Very Reverend Paul Rivard excels in his ministry in that holy place. On 20th May, it was superb to ordain the Reverend Mr. Anthony Kevin Isley to the Sacred Order of Deacons at Saint John's Church, Greensboro, North Carolina. Deacon Kevin is a senior seminarian at Nashotah House Seminary and assists the Rector, the Venerable Mark Menees - in my birthplace of Greensboro. A fantastic clergy team and parish, and a special city.

In June, I was gratified to celebrate the annual Solemn Mass, Eucharistic Procession, and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament for the Feast of Corpus Christi at Saint Barnabas Cathedral, Atlanta. On Sunday 11th June, a tremendous and supernal milestone was reached as I collaborated with the Very Reverend Daniel Trout in the official blessing and dedication of the new Saint Barnabas Cathedral building complex in Dunwoody, Georgia. The new parish hall, choir room, flower room, gathering space, kitchen, nursery wing for infants and toddlers, parish offices, classrooms, and Diocesan offices were all immersed in prayer and copious amounts of holy water as the entire edifice was dedicated and offered to the glory of Almighty God. The 'Building in Christ' and 'Completion in Christ' capital campaigns in Atlanta have been among the most successful in the history of the Continuing Church, and we are profoundly grateful to God for His overflowing blessings in the gift of our new Cathedral building.

The 2023 Anglican Camp in Surry County, North Carolina was, as foretold, a rousing triumph this year, and we look forward to hearing all about the accomplishment from Dean Matthew Harlow at our upcoming Synod. It was decided that I needed a break from Camp again this year after dealing with a respiratory issue, so during that week I instead paid a visit to

Saint Matthias Church, Dothan, Alabama, and received a tour of the truly splendid and impressive new Church building rising there. Opportunity was also given to meet with the Vestry during my brief stay.

In a spirit of gratitude and thanksgiving, the Right Reverend David Haines, our Missionary Bishop, and I were finally able to travel to Calgary, Alberta, Canada for the Episcopal Consecration of the Most Reverend Richard Rajesh Kumar Panyem as Presiding Bishop of the Anglican Church of India (APA) and Bishop Ordinary of the Diocese of Andra Pradesh and Telangana on Thursday 22nd June. We were graciously hosted by All Saints' Anglican Catholic Church in Renfrew, Calgary, and a total of twelve bishops participated in the imposition of hands. The Consecration, for which I served for the first time as a Chief Consecrator, coincided with the College of Bishops meeting of the Traditional Anglican Church (TAC). Please pray most fervently for Bishop Richard and his wife Saritha as they begin their new ministry and labour in the Lord.

On 1st July, a most beautiful occasion was celebrated by friends and family from near and far as the Reverend Father Raymond Davison married his beloved fiancé Joy (née) Strawbridge in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. The glorious nuptial Mass in a local church was attended by over 200 people, with a fabulous outdoor reception following on a family farm. The event itself and its surrounding observances were awesomely heartwarming. We pray earnestly for Father Ray and Joy Davison as they begin their new married life together and their shared ministry of teaching at Saint Paul's Church and Classical School in Melbourne, Florida.

On $2^{\rm nd}$ July, it was a treat to visit All Saints' Church, Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and the Reverend Father James Johnson. A fulsome congregation of 25 souls joined us for the Sunday Mass and the brunch reception.

Impending Events

After a delay due to illness earlier this spring, it will be a relief and pleasure finally to make an episcopal visitation on 29th and 30th July to Saint James-on-the-Glebe Church in Gloucester, Virginia, where I will consecrate and bless the new Church cemetery. It is always a profound gift to visit with Father Kevin Fife, his wife Mary Willis, their children, and the faithful of the congregation. They are verily doing the Lord's work in that august and historic parish.

On 5^{th} August, I will be privileged, after a long period of joyful anticipation, to ordain the Reverend Mr. Clyde Wilkins to the Sacred Order of Deacons at Christ the Redeemer Church, Warner Robins, Georgia, where Deacon Clyde will serve as assistant to the Very Reverend Matthew Harlow. Deacon Wilkins brings a wealth of personal and practical ministerial experience to his new ministry. On Sunday 6th August, I shall make my annual episcopal visitation to the parish of Christ the Redeemer on its patronal festival of the Transfiguration of Our Lord.

On the weekend of 13^{th} August, I shall make an episcopal visitation to Saint Paul's Church, Crownsville, Maryland, and on the following Tuesday, the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, it will be my supreme honour to ordain the Reverend Father David Hodil to the Sacred Order of Priests. Father Hodil, an old friend of mine, began his Catholic life and service in the APA some twenty years ago and then endured a detour through the Roman Ordinariate before coming home and being able to fulfil his vocation to the Holy Priesthood in Mother Church. Although a circuitous route was taken, it was well worth the wait, and we are thrilled that Father David will soon be a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek in the bosom of the Ecclesia Anglicana. Father Hodil will assist the Reverend Father Wesley Walker at Saint Paul's Church.

From $17^{th}\hbox{-}19^{th}$ August, I am scheduled to participate in the biannual meeting of the Anglican Joint Synods (G3)- Polish National Catholic Church Dialogue via Zoom. Please continue to pray for the work and progress of this significant discussion.

Delayed because of ongoing construction, the blessing and dedication of the new building at Saint Matthias Church, Dothan, Alabama, and the institution of the Reverend Father Stephen Miller as Rector of Saint Matthias will occur on the weekend of 27th August.

In September, visitations loom at Saint Philip's Church, Blacksburg, Virginia (16th-17th), and Holy Cross Church, Knoxville, Tennessee (23rd-24th).

And then what we have all been expecting will emerge faster than imagined, the annual Diocesan Synod of the Eastern United States and the Provincial Synod of the Anglican Province of America, to be held at the third Anglican Joint Synods (G3) from 9^{th} to 14^{th} October in Orlando, Florida! It will indeed be here before we know it. Please make your plans now to register and attend. The Joint Synods this year will feature special presentations, teaching, and conversation on the current state of the Continuing Church and the ways by which we can renew mission building, priestly vocations, and Church expansion in future. I shall be joining a public panel in these prescient and meaningful deliberations. Please don't miss Synod 2023, which will surely prove to be one of the most informative and illuminating in which we have ever engaged. All the necessary information will be found in this Epistle.

It is always a grace beyond compare to visit our churches, family, and friends for annual episcopal visitations, Confirmations, receptions of new members, ordinations, prayer, and ecumenical effort. Together we are expanding the Catholic and Apostolic Church. Please continually pray for our clergy, people, and parishes. Our Church is pressing on the Kingdom! <u>Anglican Youth Camp 2023 - Report from Fr. Harlow</u> Thirty-four Anglicans campers descended on Westfield, North Carolina in the Blue Ridge Mountains for our annual Summer camp this year from June 11th-16th. As a group, we stayed in 8 cabins in the woods with over five acres of land to ourselves complete with bathroom and shower facilities. Our day began with Morning Prayer at 7:15 and Mass at 7:30 each day, followed by breakfast. Fr. Sean McDermott led our

Anglican Studies for the second year, exploring what friendships and relationships mean, with each other and with God. Each day we did up to three different camp activities, including shooting, basketball, canoeing, swimming, wall climbing, and for the first time, a zip line!

This is our second year back to camp after taking two years off because of the pandemic. We hope to continue to grow so that each parish in the diocese that has children ages 8-16, can send their youth to camp with us. We have moved camp to the second week in June, which should allow most, if not all, of the youth from school districts in our diocese to attend.
